**WINNIE:** (She enters carrying a glass of dirty water and singing her song to the tune of "Here We Go

'Round the Mulberry Bush.") Here we go 'round this great big world, this great big world, this great big world. Here we go 'round this great big world, telling people 'bout Jesus. Hi, everyone.

**INTERVIEWER:** Hi, Winnie. Why are you carrying that glass of dirty water? You're not going to drink that are

you?

**WINNIE:** No, I'm not, but there are millions of people around the world who do drink water like this

because they don't have clean water to drink.

**INTERVIEWER:** That's terrible, Winnie. I can't imagine only having dirty water to drink. Doesn't water like that

make people sick?

**WINNIE:** Yes, it does. The place with the biggest problem in getting clean drinking water is Africa.

**INTERVIEWER:** Why is clean drinking water so hard to get in Africa?

**WINNIE:** Most people live in villages that have no way to pump water. In order to get water, they have to

walk long distances to rivers and lakes. This water is very dirty, especially because all the animals

use this water to bathe in.

**INTERVIEWER:** Do we have missionaries helping with this problem?

**WINNIE:** Yes. The Assemblies of God has formed the Africa Oasis Project that is committed to getting

clean, safe drinking water to the people all over Africa.

**INTERVIEWER:** How are they doing that, Winnie?

**WINNIE:** The missionaries working with the Africa Oasis Project help in four different ways. First, they dig

water wells in places that need clean water. Secondly, they teach the people how to collect and

store clean rain water.

**INTERVIEWER:** That's a great idea. Rain water is free, and it's clean when it falls from the sky. If people can

learn to collect it and store it, they can have clean water when they need it.

**WINNIE:** Thirdly, the people are taught how to keep their water wells clean and in good working

condition so they'll have water for many years. And lastly, the people are taught how to protect

the soil and how to deal with drought.

**INTERVIEWER:** Drought happens when it doesn't rain. This can be a big problem in many places in Africa.

It sounds like the Africa Oasis Project is a much-needed ministry. Can you give us more

information about how they dig the water wells?

**WINNIE:** Digging a water well can cost a lot of money, and BGMC is helping to pay for water wells all

over Africa. When a well is dug, it's usually dug next to a Bible school or a church so that the Christians can take care of the well and tell people about Jesus when they come to get water.

**INTERVIEWER:** That's a great idea, Winnie. People come to get water and then hear about the Living Water of

Jesus, who can cure their spiritual thirst. It's also exciting to hear that the kids here in America

are helping the people in Africa get water by giving to BGMC!

**WINNIE:** Oh yes. Many, many people get saved when they come to get water. It's a great witnessing tool

for the Christians. BGMC is also helping to pay for Buddy Buckets.

**INTERVIEWER:** Buddy Buckets? What are Buddy Buckets?

**WINNIE:** The missionaries noticed that people were coming to get water in old dirty plastic containers. So

they had the idea to provide clean buckets for the people to put their water in. Since BGMC is

providing the buckets, Buddy's face is on each bucket given out.

**INTERVIEWER:** That's really interesting, Winnie. Buddy is going all over Africa. The people in Africa most likely

don't know who Buddy Barrel is, but when they see his smiling face, they'll know that kids in

America care enough about them to give money for the buckets and the water.

**WINNIE:** Thanks, kids, for giving to BGMC! Every penny you give is important to God, and all those

pennies add up so that our missionaries have the money to help people all over the world.

Thank you for all that you do to raise money for BGMC!

**INTERVIEWER:** Thank you for coming today, Winnie, and for telling us about the exciting ministry of the Africa
