WINNIE: BGMC has provided money to supply the Bible schools with Bibles, books, and materials to train

Sunday School materials translated. BGMC has been a big help in Russia.

INTERVIEWER: The kids here in America help missionaries all over the world with the supplies they need to

spread the gospel message. I'm so glad the kids here give their money to missions to reach the

lost.

WINNIE: BGMC also helps the churches in Russia with children's ministry materials and equipment. Keep
