WINNIE:	Yes. We have missionaries working in the Czech Republic, but the work has been very hard. Only about 1 in 10 people believe God exists. Many, many cities have no churches at all.

- WINNIE: They are helping to start churches, they witness to students on the college campuses, they've started Royal Rangers, they have kids camps and kids outreaches, and they teach in the Bible school.
- **INTERVIEWER:** Sounds like our missionaries are busy letting people know that God is real and that He does exist! How did BGMC start in the Czech Republic?
- **WINNIE:** Missionaries saw how important BGMC is, and they wanted the kids in the Czech Republic to learn about countries, people groups, and missions work around the world. They also wanted to teach kids to pray, to give, and to someday go and be missionaries.
- **INTERVIEWER:** That's exciting, Winnie. BGMC teaches kids to have a heart for missions and to care about people all over the world. Did the kids in the United States help get the BGMC program in the Czech Republic started?
- **WINNIE:** Yes. BGMC here paid to get the BGMC lessons translated and printed for the Czech churches. BGMC has also helped to get a missions kit put together with lots of missions resources for the churches. Thank you, kids, for giving to BGMC.
- **INTERVIEWER:** Now kids in the Czech Republic are learning about missions. They are also learning to keep their hearts open to the call of God to go to other countries as missionaries someday. Do they collect BGMC offerings?
- **WINNIE:** Yes they do. They have their own offering banks, and the money they give helps their own missionaries.
- **INTERVIEWER:** This is so amazing, Winnie! Thank you for coming today and sharing with us about the Czech Republic and how the BGMC program is being started in countries around the world. Good-bye.
