

Speedy D. Light Skit

Speedy D. Light represents the Speed the Light missions program for teenagers. Teens raise money to buy vehicles and other equipment for missionaries. These vehicles are often used to transport materials purchased by BGMC. The vehicles take our missionaries wherever they need to go in order to reach the lost. For this skit, use the Speedy puppet or print out the Speedy picture onto card stock and attach to a craft stick to create a stick puppet.



(As the skit begins, Speedy comes racing from behind stage. Screeching car brakes are heard and up pops Speedy. He has a Spanish accent and talks very fast. He hardly stops for a breath. When he gets too excited, he beeps. His catchy key line is, "I am so excited! Beep! Beep!")

Hey! Speedy D. Light here. Just wait until you hear how missionaries David and Carolyn Huneycutt are using BGMC and Speed the Light to help them reach the kids of Mexico! *I am so excited! Beep! Beep!*

The Huneycutts are working in a very poor area of Mexico. This area is called the "Dark Heart of Mexico" because there are so few Christians there. God told them to go there and teach the Christian workers how to reach the kids for Jesus. They have started clubs for the kids. The clubs are full of fun things like clowns, songs, games, and prizes. The kids have a blast, and they learn all about Jesus. Many of the clown supplies, sound systems, games, and prizes are supplied by you kids when you give to BGMC! Way to go, kids! You are helping to reach the kids of Mexico. *I am so excited! Beep! Beep!*

The missionaries also couldn't do their ministry without Speed the Light money given by teenagers in the U.S. The Speed the Light offerings paid for a van for the Huneycutts to use.
